Peter Hall has just handed over a cheque for Rps147,000, being AU\$2,000 from the Rotary Club of Kyneton,  
to Tej Gurung, President of the Rotary Club of Pokhara Fishtail.

The Fishtail Club is engaged in a number of earthquake restoration projects:

\* With RC Dronfield, UK, the rebuilding of Prithvi Rupa Secondary school, Rupakot VDC, 25km east from Pokhara. Pokhara Fishtail will oversee the construction of the two storey six rooms and toilet with the financial support of the Rotary Club of Dronfield UK. The total cost estimation of this project is NPR. 7,000,000 - (£40,000 to £50,000) and will hopefully be completed within six months.

\* With RC Bristol, UK - driven by Ron Stagg and Tim Mitchell, that Club has joined with others to initiate and co-ordinate a Global Grant of around £120 000 to rebuild 6 schools in the area around Pokhara

\* At a Club meeting attended by Peter Hall, a representative of Sahara UK and Sahara Nepal Football Clubs advised the availability of GBP 100,000 for school reconstruction

\* At the same meeting, Colonel John White, Deputy Director of The Gurkha Welfare Trust, announced a program to rebuild 9 schools this year and another 12 next year.

Tej extends his thanks to RC Kyneton for its monetary support for earthquake victims of Nepal.
